Youth is defined as an individual age 18 and under, no younger than 10, *unless enrolled in the Y's Early Childhood Education program.

Individual Family is defined as a single individual age 19 or older with dependent children under the age of 19, unless child is under the age of 26 and enrolled as a full-time student, and/or dependent adults residing at the same household. This includes elderly parents living with their children, live-in nannies or au pairs and dependent adult children with a disability. Proof of residence required.

Adult Household is defined as two individuals age 19 or older living in the same household. For each additional adult add \$30 per month, maximum four adults per household. Proof of residence required.

Family is defined as two individuals in a committed relationship with dependent children under the age of 19, unless child is under the age of 26 and enrolled as a full-time student, and/or dependent adults residing at the same household. This includes elderly parents living with their children, live-in nannies or au pairs and dependent adult children with a disability. For each family member over the age of 19 not enrolled in school full-time and not considered dependent, add \$15 per month, per individual. Proof of residence required.

How do Employees Qualify for Discounted Membership?

- Visit a YMCA of Metropolitan Milwaukee center, prove employment (id badge or pay check stub).
- Existing members will need to follow up with their Y to prove employment (present badge or pay check stub). Discounts will be applied to their next bank draft or when their invoiced membership is renewed.
