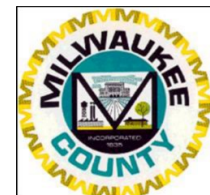

Community Services for Adults

Targeted Case Management (TCM)

APC contracts with Milwaukee County to provide case management and other supportive services to adults with mental health and/or substance use concerns. We connect participants to various resources, which assists them to thrive and live independently in the community.

Comprehensive Community Services (CCS)

Through this program, APC provides a comprehensive array of recovery services, treatment, and psychosocial rehabilitation services that assist individuals in utilizing professional, community, and natural supports to address their needs.

It is a recovery-focused, integrated behavioral health program for qualifying individuals who have Medical Assistance and have a mental illness and/or substance use diagnosis.
